Financial Update

The financial state of the church is in need of support. This is not new in the summer or in the life of our church since the building addition from 2008. Currently, we are months behind in paying Pastor Dan's insurance and pension. We are months behind in paying for our lawn care. And we have not been able to support our missions nearly at all in 2024. Our church is essential. We love our church and need to give what we can to support our missions and ministries. Each month, we fall behind our monthly budget by about \$3,000 to \$5,000. This leaves us with just enough to cover the monthly building payment and Pastor Dan's salary and a little to put towards one bill or another. The Council and Finance Team is looking into other / new income streams for the church to complement what the congregation gives. Any additional gifts or increases in your giving are much appreciated and will help us start to catch up. If each church member could give \$300 to \$350 to the church each month, we would make our congregationally approved budget. Some church members can and do give more. Some church members are unable to give at that rate and give what they can. Each gift is celebrated. Thank you for giving what you can and increasing if you are able to keep our ministries relevant in our community and beyond.



A New Church Building Project is Started -- A financial consultant group (Haney Associates) was hired to conduct a building fund campaign. This campaign netted \$96,296.00. A Building Committee was formed. It included Keith Lowing, Howard Perrin, Del Giem, Marjorie DeWeerd, Joe Kooyman, Jerry Bricker, Vern Huyser, and Gordon Smedley. They recommended dropping a previous plan to remodel the present church. They proposed a revised remodeling plan. The congregation rejected this. By March 18, 1969, the congregation approved building a new church on a new site. This vote required two resolutions to amend the Constitution because the Michigan Conference had certain controls over the church. These controls were based on a court ruling from legal action involving the Hudsonville Church in the 1930s. THe first resolution stated that the Hudsonville Church has the right to manage property, but if the church ceases to exist as a member in full of the Michigan Conference, the ownership will go to the Michigan Conference. The second resolution stated that the name be changed to Congregational United Church of Christ of Hudsonville. These resolutions were approved June 29, 1969.
