<u>A Moment in</u> Church History

In 1967, Rev. Eldon Cummings was called as the new pastor. He served as pastor until his retirement in 1981. His wife Tillie was very active in the life of the church she was involved in activities including the choir and church secretary. they had four sons. three of the sons were already married when the Cummings arrived in 1967. two of them were ministers and the third was considering ministry. The fourth son, Jay, was pursuing ministry at that time.

This was to be the beginning of several new programs and traditions in the church as well as the construction of the new church. The first Christmas Eve Candlelight Communion Service was held: registration pads were put into use for the worship service; junior boys and girls were chosen to act as acolytes. Robes and candle lighters for them were given as memorials by different church members.
